On what legal basis is personal data processed?

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is here the voluntary and informed consent according to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. a) DSGVO.

Which personal data is processed and for how long is it stored?

The following personal data are processed in the following processing situations:

In the representation of the institution, contact persons in the institution are recorded with name, function, telephone number and e-mail address.

Personal data will be deleted after revocation or after discontinuation of the web presence.

Auf der Internetseite sind Angaben zur Institution sowie Ansprechpartner in der Institution mit Name, Funktion, Telefonnummer und Email-Adresse sichtbar. Darüber hinaus und insofern dies nicht anders gesetzlich bestimmt ist oder Sie ausdrücklich eingewilligt haben, erfolgt keine Übermittlung von personenbezogenen Daten an Dritte.

What are the basic rights of data subjects?

In order to claim the rights, a notification in text form (letter, e-mail or fax) to the responsible person is sufficient. However, the exercise of the rights will only have an effect if the processed data allows the identification of a natural person.

1) Voluntary nature and revocation according to Art. 7 para. 3 DSGVO

The provision of personal data is voluntary. Consent to the processing of personal data can be revoked at any time in accordance with Art. 7 Para. 3 DSGVO with the consequence that the personal data of the person concerned will not be further processed.

2) Right to information (Art. 15 DSGVO)

The data subjects have the right to request information at any time about the data processed concerning them and the possible recipients of such data. They are entitled to a reply within a

period of one month after receipt of the request for information.

3) Right to correction, deletion and restriction (Art. 16 - 18 DSGVO)

The persons concerned may at any time request the TU Dresden to correct or delete their personal data or to restrict the processing of such data.

4) Right to data transferability (Art. 20 DSGVO)

The data subjects may request that the data controller provide them with their personal data in machine-readable format. Alternatively, they may request that the personal data provided by you be transferred directly to another data controller, insofar as this is possible.

5) Right of complaint (Art. 77 DSGVO)

Data subjects can contact the data protection officer of the TU Dresden at any time and, in case of a complaint according to Art. 77 DSGVO, the responsible supervisory authority for data protection. The competent supervisory authority is:
